Job Responsibilities:

- Maintain a clean and professional appearance in line with company uniform standards.
- Prompt attendance consistent with scheduled hours.
- Work collaboratively and in a professional manner with all allied health and public safety personnel.
- Receive, prioritize, and evaluate emergent and non-emergent calls for service. (Non-911)
- Maintaining communication with emergency personnel via radio, mobile data terminal, phone, pager and in person.
- Utilize current Emergency Medical Dispatching (EMD) protocols to provide interim assistance to callers until EMS arrives.
- May be called upon to train new dispatch staff, monitor performance, provide instruction, prepare training evaluations, and prepare weekly goals.
- Deliver work products and services with responsiveness, courtesy, and tact in personal interactions with customers, agency employees and staff.

- Shifts are 10-12 Hour Shifts
